### REGISTRATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### Who can register?

1. Registrations are only available for **specific, named individuals** who will be attending the conference.
2. It is **not possible to purchase generic places** where the attending delegate is not yet known. To register someone, we require individual information such as their dietary needs, access requirements and contact details. Therefore, please

determine who will be attending before attempting your booking.

3. Registrations may not be shared between delegates. Each person must register separately, and places may not be "split" between people.

## How to register

4. Registration **occurs online**, using our electronic system – [Humanitix Event Page](#)
5. People who have difficulties with the electronic form should contact us on [wa.familypathwaynetwork@relationshipswa.org.au](mailto:wa.familypathwaynetwork@relationshipswa.org.au) for individual assistance. Note: our team are not available every business day.
6. Payments must be made **online** via the electronic registration system. This electronic payment system is used because it keeps administrative costs down and therefore minimises registration fees.
7. Places cannot be held without payment.
8. Delegates unable to pay online **may request an invoice**.

## Metro vs Regional Registrations

Delegates may register to attend **in person at our metro location** (Perth)

\*Please note livestream is not available.

9. In the event of a COVID (or any other) lockdown impacting Perth, meaning that the face-to-face conference cannot proceed, the conference is likely to be cancelled, in which case no refunds will be issued, and tickets will be rolled over to the 2027 event. Delegates can register themselves or choose to transfer their tickets to a colleague.
10. **Should you become unwell we recommend you do not attend the event.** Refund or reimbursement will not be available, instead you may transfer your ticket to another colleague. In this instance, please advise the new attendee's name, role, and dietary requirements via email at [WA.FamilyPathwayNetwork@relationshipswa.org.au](mailto:WA.FamilyPathwayNetwork@relationshipswa.org.au).
11. Please note that legal CPD points apply for attendance to those who can provide a relevant PID. CPD points for other professions may be available as advised by your industry peak body.

## Cancellations

12. Cancellations received in writing ([WA.FamilyPathwayNetwork@relationshipswa.org.au](mailto:WA.FamilyPathwayNetwork@relationshipswa.org.au)) by **28 April 2026** will be accepted and all fees refunded.
13. Cancellations received after 28 April 2026 will not be refunded but may be transferred to another person in accordance with clauses 9 and 10.

## Changes to details and preferences

14. Electronic changes to conference delegate registrations may be made up until **5pm 28 April 2026**. Changes should be made using the "edit" function available for your booking in the online registration system (i.e. Humanitix), and do not incur a charge.
15. After **28 April 2026**, electronic changes will not be possible, meaning custom details such as name badges and dietary requirements may not be able to be accommodated. However, in the case of last-minute issues, an alternative delegate may be sent on the day to replace someone unable to attend.

## Photography and video

16. **By registering, delegates are acknowledging that they may be photographed** at some point during the conference.
17. Delegates are welcome to take and share photos by uploading them through the 'send to drive' app to a folder on our Google drive. These images will not be visible to the public. All photos will be reviewed before being added to the members' area of the WAFLPN website.
18. Delegates are invited to take photographs during the event using their own film equipment/mobile devices. The network has no copyright over these and if you do not wish to be photographed, please inform the delegate and ask them to ensure you are not captured.

## Accommodation and travel

19. This is a non-residential conference and all accommodation, travel and transport arrangements and any associated costs are the **responsibility of the individual delegate**, except where otherwise specifically agreed to by the WAFLPN.
20. WAFLPN has partnered with [Residence on Langley](#) in Perth to offer delegates attending the conference a discounted accommodation rate. Delegates can use the promo code **WAFAMILYLAW26** to receive a 25% discount when booking.
21. Delegates from outside Perth need to organise their own travel and accommodation and everyone is responsible for their own transport to and from the event venue.
22. The WAFLPN invites sole trading practitioners and small not-for-profit organisations who are responsible for funding their own activities and would otherwise struggle to meet their annual professional development requirements to apply for a 2026 travel subsidy.
